Overview of Cookie Usage

At ADAMftd Pte Ltd ("ADAMftd"), a Singapore incorporated company, we utilize cookies to enhance and personalize your experience on our platform. Cookies are small data files that are placed on your device as you navigate our website, helping us improve functionality, performance, and security.

What are Cookies?

Definition and Function of Cookies

Cookies are small text files sent from a website and stored on the user's computer by the user's web browser while the user is browsing. Cookies are designed to be a reliable mechanism for websites to remember stateful information or to record the user's browsing activity.

Types of Cookies Used

- Session Cookies: These are temporary cookies used to remember you during the course of your visit to the website, and they expire when you close the web browser.
- **Persistent Cookies**: Persistent cookies remain on your device for a set period specified in the cookie and are activated each time you visit the website that created that particular cookie.
- **Third-Party Cookies**: These cookies are set by a domain other than the one you are visiting, typically used for advertising and marketing efforts by third-party services.

How We Use Cookies

Essential Cookies: Necessary for Basic Site Functionality

These cookies are essential to provide you with services available through our website and to use some of its features, such as access to secure areas. Without these cookies, basic functions like page navigation and access to secure areas of the website would not work.

Performance Cookies: Collecting Analytics and Performance Data

Performance cookies collect information about how you use our website, like which pages you visited and which links you clicked on. None of this information can be used to identify you. It is all aggregated and, therefore, anonymized. Their sole purpose is to improve website functions, which includes ensuring that users can find what they need easily.

Functionality Cookies: Enhancing User Experience

Functionality cookies allow our website to remember choices you make (such as your user name, language, or the region you are in) and provide enhanced, more personal features. They can also be used to remember changes you have made to text size, fonts, and other parts of web pages that you can customize.

Targeting or Advertising Cookies: Delivering Personalized Advertising

These cookies track your browsing habits to enable us to show advertising which is more likely to be of interest to you. These cookies use information about your browsing history to group you with other users who have similar interests. Based on that information, and with our permission, third-party advertisers can place cookies



to enable them to show adverts which we think will be relevant to your interests while you are on third-party websites.

How to Control or Delete Cookies

You have the ability to accept or decline cookies through your web browser settings. Most browsers automatically accept cookies, but you can usually modify your browser setting to decline cookies if you prefer. Detailed instructions for managing cookies can be found in the 'Help' section of your web browser.

There are various tools available that can help you control your cookie preferences:

- Browser Settings: You can set your browser to accept all cookies, to notify you when a cookie is
 issued, or not to receive cookies at any time.

When you visit our site for the first time, you will be prompted with an option to accept or reject the use of certain cookies. This includes third-party cookies. You can customize your preferences for each type of cookie through our cookie consent tool.

- Data Encryption: Encrypting sensitive data transmitted via cookies.
- Strict Access Controls: Limiting access to cookie-related data to authorized personnel only.
- **Regular Audits**: Conducting regular audits to ensure compliance with data protection standards and to address any potential security vulnerabilities.
